The iKamvelihle Development Trust (iKDT) is a non-profit organisation with a focus on education. It is supporting a cluster of 12 Senior Secondary Schools and some of their feeder ECD centres and Primary Schools in the Chris Hani District of the Eastern Cape Province. The iKDT supports government programmes and adds substantial value by working in partnership with **individuals** and **organisations** that are committed to human resource development, particularly in poor communities, such as the Nelson Mandela University (NMU) and the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA).

Consider these examples:

### Bathandwa Ndondo SSS

whose matric pass rate in 2017 has increased by 18%, with better quality of bachelor passes and a 67.6% pass rate. This rate is higher when compared to the Eastern Cape provincial average of 65%.

### Yibanathi Nkosana

(see picture) of Batandwa Ndondo SSS achieved five distinctions (Mathematics, Physical Sciences, Life Sciences, isiXhosa, Life Orientation) and Level 6 in English and Geography

The iKDT believes in partnering with parents and enabling their role in education. In the picture below is the mother of Yibanathi Nkosana. This is what she said last year during an event which served as a motivation to students:

*"I tell my children that education is important and nobody can take it away from you. Trust in yourself, respect your elders and at school you should be an example of what your parents have taught you."*

### Nosiphelele Tikana

achieved three distinctions (English, Xhosa and Life Orientation)
